## PRESS RELEASE

**Subject:** Serious Crash - Motor vehicle versus pedestrian

On Friday, January 26, 2018 at approximately 9:04 p.m., the New Britain Police, Fire and EMS Departments responded to the area of 460 Burritt Street for a report of a serious crash involving a motor vehicle and a pedestrian.

The pedestrian is a 61 year old female New Britain resident who sustained serious, life threatening injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment where she is listed in critical condition.

The operator of the motor vehicle, a 46 year old male New Britain resident, was not injured and is cooperating with the investigation. There have not been any charges filed at this time.

The New Britain Police Department's Traffic Safety Bureau responded to process the scene and continue the investigation. The area has since been reopened to traffic.
