The New Britain Police Department is excited to announce that we are accepting applications for the position of police officer starting immediately.

The application process for many police departments can take up to several months before you get a response. That's not the case with the NBPd. We have fast-tracked our hiring process.

Anyone interested in applying who currently holds a valid Chip card can visit policeapp.com and submit their application under the New Britain Police Department tab. The applicant will quickly receive a reply from the Human Resources Department with their written test appointment. The target date for the written exam is July 31st, 2018.

For anyone who does not currently hold a valid chip card, there is a Chip test on July 24th, 2018. Please check the Chip Test website for location and registration: (<https://www.ichiptest.com/pre-employment/>). Once a valid Chip card is obtained, the applicant should go directly to policeapp.com and apply for the New Britain Police Department.

Applicants must have a valid Chip card to apply online with policeapp.com

All applicants who pass the written exam will immediately move onto the background phase.

The New Britain Police Department hosts our own Police Academy. The target date for the next session is October, 2018.
